

The Outstanding Rural Health Program of the Year Award recognizes a statewide or regional program that promotes the development of rural health care delivery systems; promotes and/or provides increased access to health care services for rural populations or that improves the quality of rural health care through outreach and education. Factors taken into consideration include coordination, networking, innovation, and lasting impact. The Louisiana Rural Health Association is honored to name **LifePhases Consulting**, **LLC** (LifePhases) as the 2023 Outstanding Rural Health Program of the Year award recipient.

LifePhases Consulting, LLC was founded in 2011 under the leadership of Sherry Banks, M.S.N., R.N., B.C and Jill Elias, M.S.W., L.C.S.W. Combined, these two outstanding, goal driven, and innovative leaders, have 45 years of specialized experience in the field of formulating rural health delivery systems.

LifePhases began with opening Intensive Outpatient Psychiatric Services (IOPs), Partial Hospitalization Units, and In-Patient Psychiatric Units in rural hospitals that had limited access to psychiatric community services. Their expertise and involvement in rural health services has recently expanded to consulting with different facilities and hospitals across the state of Louisiana. In recent years, LifePhases has assisted Rural Health Clinics and Federally Qualified Health Centers in providing Psychiatric and Mental Health Therapy, Medication Management services, and Substance Abuse Clinics. LifePhases is skilled in opening and maintaining these programs, through either short-term consulting or long-term consulting and their collaboration gives the community the knowledge and access to services that will meet the needs of patients locally and effectively.

LifePhases has consulted with, collaborated with, and opened many services for hospitals and clinics including Union General Hospital, Hartdner Medical Center, Richland Parish/Delhi Hospital, Delhi FQHC, Madison Parish Hospital, Morehouse General Hospital, Claiborne Medical Center, and West Feliciana Hospital, among others.
